Vaccinations For Holiday Travel

If you are travelling abroad on holiday, you will want to make sure that your holiday is not spoiled by any avoidable illness, and that you protect yourself against any diseases which are more common overseas and rare in this country. Nowadays, travelling to exotic locations is not unusual, and although standards of sanitation and cleanliness abroad, especially in holiday hotels, is often good significant risks still occur.

Many countries do not **require** vaccinations: it is possible to travel without any cover. Certainly many thousands of Britons choose to go abroad without protecting themselves at all. This may be unwise. We will be pleased to advise on the recommended vaccinations for your trip and if you wish, for us to provide this for you. Please book a routine surgery appointment.

It is important to remember that it is necessary to have many of these vaccinations well in advance of travel, so it is prudent to talk to us about two months before your intended departure.

What Will It Cost?

We do not charge for providing advice, and it is possible that some of the cost of your travel vaccination will be met under the regulations of the National Health Service. However, the rules are complicated, and you should be aware that it is likely that there will be some charges which **you** will have to meet.

Travel vaccination costs fall into two categories:

- the cost of the vaccine
- a fee for administering the vaccine

Depending upon the vaccinations required, one or more of these charges may be met by the Health Authority. Overleaf, there is a table of common vaccinations and a break-down of the charges you may have to bear. We will be happy to undertake all these vaccinations for you, and will inform you in advance what the total charges will be.

Finally, you are quite entitled to seek help for travel vaccinations and advice from other clinics.
