How likely are you to recommend our GP practice to friends and family if they needed similar care or treatment?

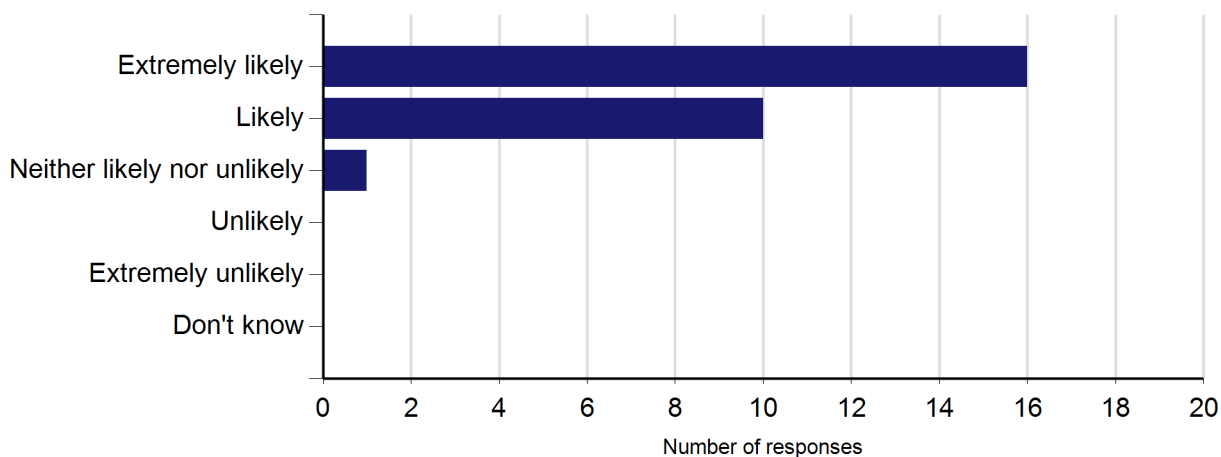

Please tell us why you answered as you did in question 1:

- When I am struggling I always feel reassured. The receptionist helped me when I was in a panic on the phone.
- Receptionists very helpful. They will try to give a GP or nurse appointment.
- One doctor is an excellent doctor, efficient, caring and considerate. They have helped me with numerous medical problems since they arrived. The reception staff are also very helpful and the nurses are also very good.
- Excellent practice. Very accommodating with appointments. Concerned and caring.
- Able to get appointments fairly quickly. Very helpful receptionists. Very happy with GP.
- Always treated with respect.
- It's always been a good practice to me.
- Staff and doctors are very friendly.
- Prompt appointments. Helpful and kind doctors.
- Since joining the practice many months ago, I have been greatly impressed by the time, care and depth of interest that all the staff have shown and provided me. The best doctor I have had!
- It is a wonderful practice and all the staff look after my mother extremely well. My mother loves one doctor and all the nurses.
- Efficient and friendly service. Clean and tidy environment. I feel I have been heard by the doctor.
- Very happy so far but mostly registered so only has 3 or 4 visits. Not yet seen my named doctor but had appointments with another doctor.

Please tell us why you answered as you did in question 1:

- One doctor used to have a variety of available appointments but when booking online appointment are now only early morning or late afternoon. It would be more appropriate to have the previous timetable restored. More availability would be great and an afternoon drop-in surgery.
- Friendly staff and doctor.
- Friendly, can usually get an appointment fairly easily.
- Appointment booked in short time.
- The medical staff and service are excellent. The administration is awful. Staff are rude, obnoxious and obstructive.
- Doctors are amazingly nice and understanding. Only practitioner gives injections very differently not very pleased but rest is super good.
- Friendly reception - usually get to see a doctor quickly.
- Pleasant atmosphere and friendly staff.
- Lovely receptionist.

Additional information on the Friends and Family Test

The Friends and Family Test (FFT) is a feedback tool that supports the fundamental principle that people who use NHS services should have the opportunity to provide feedback on their experience that can be used to improve services. It is not a traditional survey. It is a continuous feedback loop between patients and practices.

Practices can use the feedback gathered through the FFT to celebrate successes and to support staff to make improvements where the experience of service does not live up to expectations. FFT results are also one useful source of information which can help to inform choice for patients and the public.
